

## Key Stage 2 Educational Activities

Each of the following activities forms part of a two hour taught workshop at the Museum of Brands:

### Collections Bank – Show and Tell

Children are introduced to the Museum and its collection before being given the opportunity to contribute their own item to our Collections Bank for future preservation.

Children are able to handle original items from the Museum collections, learning how to date both these objects and others from our collection.

### Packaging Design and Construction

Children learn about various features of packaging across different eras, before using examples to inspire the creation and construction of their own pack.
