

Create your own bunting



Step-by-Step

- Cut a piece of string and make sure it is as long as you want your bunting to be. You may need to measure your rooms if you want it to hang all the way across one wall.
- 2 Find some old packaging like crisp packets, plastic bags or cereal boxes. Make sure any packaging you use is clean and dry. Reusing old packaging that you were going to throw away stops the material being wasted and is much kinder to the planet.
- 3 Cut some different shapes out of the packaging. You might want simple shapes like circles, or more complicated ones like butterflies or planes. Choose any shapes you like!
- 4 Step 4: Once you have finished cutting out your shapes it's time to make your bunting! You can stick your decorations directly onto the string OR cut small holes in the top of your shapes and poke the string through. If you are threading your shapes, remember to tie a knot at each end of the string so the decorations won't fall off.
 - Hang your beautiful bunting somewhere in your house to make your whole family smile!
